

UG COURSE GUIDELINES 2021 -2022

- 1) Incomplete applications and false declarations will automatically invalidate the applications.
- 2) Candidates claiming seats under Reservation (SC/ST/CAT - I / IIA /IIB/IIIA/IIIB /OBC) should produce a valid caste certificate issued by a competent authority.

Catholic (RC) Students will have to produce a letter from the parish priest stating that they are practicing Catholics along with Baptism Certificate at the time of Admission.

- 3) Differentially Abled Candidates should produce a certificate of disability or handicap issued by the District or State Medical Board.
- 4) The college does not accept Capitation fee or Donations in any form.
- 5) The college does not solicit the services of any educational agency or agents for admission.
- 6) The Management does not entertain recommendations for Admission. For any information kindly contact the college office directly.
- 7) Students are required to opt for the same second language at the UG level as was studied at the previous qualifying examination.
- 8) All foreign students have to submit two copies of their passport, marks cards duly attested by a Gazette Officer and 2 passport size photographs.
- 9) Fees should be paid in full on the day of the personal interview.
- 10) If admitted, all foreign nationals should apply for the Eligibility Certificate from Bengaluru City University through the college office.
- 11) Lists of candidates selected for admission will be announced on the College Notice Board. Candidates are advised to check the Notice Board in this regard. Candidates will not be personally intimated in this regard.
- 12) Admissions commences after the announcement of class XII / II PUC results. For BA /BSC /BVOC Courses Direct Walk-in Interview. For BCOM Cutoffs will be mentioned in the website

and College Notice Board. Courses with entrance Exams will be put up on website with entrance test dates.
