He went through the 7 criteria and how each criteria functions, at a very basic level, as ways to quantitatively measure the work an institution is doing. These criteria, he specified, were grounded in five basic core values:

- Contribution To National Development
- Fostering Global Competency
- Inculcation Moral Values
- Promoting The Use Of Technology
- Achieve A Quest For Excellence

The day's deliberations were then handed off to the members of the IQAC team of Mount Carmel College. As a team who has worked tirelessly through the strenuous 4<sup>th</sup> cycle of NAAC only mere months ago, the team came well equipped to explain and clarify any issues the members of the Mentee institutions might have with regard to what documents they might have to put together in preparation for their own NAAC accreditation cycles.
