- 8) Our Student Vaishnavi Anand won award for her start-up in the regional meet.

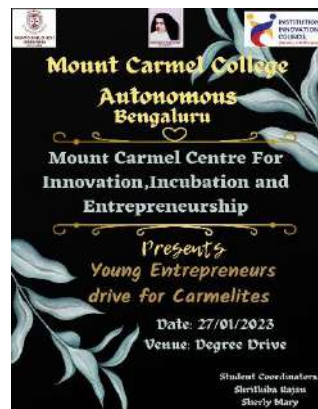


9) Skill Development Centre was set up by MCCIIIE in collaboration with KVIC On 9th December 2022.

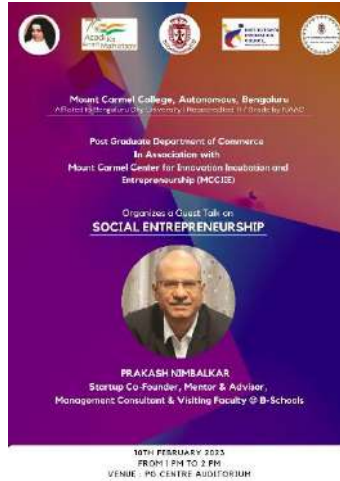
10) A Skill Development training programme was organised on Food Processing and Preservation from 9th of December to 14th December in association with KVIC for the students of Home Science.
