Undertaking by Students and Parents at the time of Admission

1. Admission is only provisional and subject to confirmation on fulfilling all the eligibility criteria of the affiliating body Bengaluru City University. The College reserves the right to cancel the provisional admission if any student does not fulfill the eligibility conditions.
2. If a student has backlog(s) at the time of provisional admission, it is solely the responsibility of the student to clear the backlog(s) before the commencement of the programme to which the student has been provisionally admitted. If, at the beginning of the programme, a student is found to have a backlog in previous examinations that makes them ineligible for the programme for which they have been provisionally admitted, their admission will stand cancelled.
3. Documents such as leaving certificate, transfer/migration certificate etc requested by the institution for verification must be submitted as and when the institution informs the students.
4. Students must pay the programme fee within the time frame mentioned in the notifications.
5. Students are required to regularly log in to the web portal, follow notifications, and comply with them accordingly
6. Classes will be held from Monday to Friday between 8:00 a.m and 4:00 p.m, and on Saturday from 9:00 a.m to 1:00 p.m according to the Time Table of the specific program for which the student has enrolled. Timings are subject to change.
7. Students are requested to conform to the dress code mentioned in the college calendar.
8. Students must be punctual, and regular for classes. They must be present in class on time. Mobile phones are strictly banned in classrooms. Discipline must be maintained inside class and on campus at all times.

9. A minimum attendance of 75% for UG and 80% for PG students is compulsory for all programmes in order for a student to appear for the semester end examinations.

10. Every student must :

- ❖ Regularly log in to the web portal, follow the notifications and comply with the same
- ❖ Submit assignments, projects and other required assessment modules within the stipulated time. Plagiarism check will be done as and when needed
- ❖ Participate in all extracurricular activities/group activities organised by the College
- ❖ Participate and present papers in seminars and conferences held by the College, and at other institutions
- ❖ Write and publish research papers in peer-reviewed Journals, in collaboration with faculty members
- ❖ Actively engage in Internship Projects especially, if it is a component of the curriculum
- ❖ Participate in Industrial Visits during the course of study
- ❖ Be part of Extension programmes/Community Development Programmes such as visits to institutions and organisations for the under privileged
- ❖ Actively participate in and contribute to departmental activities to foster leadership and organisational skills
