MOUNT CARMEL COLLEGE, AUTONOMOUS



Mount Carmel College founded in 1944 by the Carmelite Sisters of St. Teresa in the state of Kerala in Trichur (under the title of Carmel College) affiliated to Madras University, broke new ground by shifting to Bangalore in the year 1948 to meet the increasing demand for women's education.

An Autonomous college since September 2005, Mount Carmel College was first accredited at the 5 Star Level in 1999, Re-accredited with an A+ in 2006, 'A' Grade in 2012 in its third round, A+ in the 4th Cycle and A+ in the 5th Cycle of Accreditation by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC). In 2006 University Grants Commission identified the college as 'College with Potential for Excellence' (CPE). The Institution is consistently ranked among the top 20 colleges in India.

The institution offers wide range of under graduate and post graduate programs in Humanities and Social Sciences, Natural and Applied Sciences, Commerce, and Management. Presently, the college caters to the academic aspirations of over 9000 students.

MCC also offers Certificate, Diploma and Post Graduate Diploma Programs. The Centre for Extended Education (CEE) coordinates over 100 Certificate Courses offered by various departments. The institution has well-established research facilities and state-of-the-art laboratories which facilitate research culture both among staff and students. Eleven PG Departments have been recognized as research centres by Bengaluru City University and IGNOU.

The institution has been registered with the Department of Scientific and Industrial Research (DSIR) and is recognized as a Scientific and Industrial Research Organization (SIRO) by the Department of Scientific and Industrial Research, Ministry of Science and Technology, Government of India (Act 1988) in the year 2011.

MCC plays a crucial role in entrenching a strong value system. The faculty today, makes optimum use of Information and Communication Technology (ICT). It has made a conscious effort to invest in facilities, hardware, and state of the art infrastructure and has made considerable advances in documentation and knowledge management.

ADMISSION POLICY



Mount Carmel College, Autonomous (MCC) has a systematic transparent admission process that has been designed to ensure fairness and equal opportunities for all applicants. The institution firmly believes in providing equal opportunities for students based on their abilities and achievements. The admission criteria primarily involve a combination of academic records and/or entrance examinations/interviews, depending on the program.

MCC is committed to promoting diversity and inclusivity. The institution reserves 50% of the total intake for students belonging to the Roman Catholic (RC) community. Applicants seeking admission under this quota may be required to provide documentation or proof of their minority status, as per the institution's guidelines. For the remaining seats, allocation will follow category-wise guidelines and regulations established by the government, as applicable.

The admission dates and timeline for admission process are announced in the college website before the commencement of the admission for the academic year concerned. Applicants can access and submit application forms online through the web portal. A non-refundable application fee must be paid by the applicant for each application.

Applicants must submit transcripts, standardized test scores (if required), category certificate (if required), income certificate (if required) and any additional program-specific requirements. Scholarships are offered at MCC based on academic achievement and financial status. The details of the scholarships will be displayed on the student noticeboard. Students can access the application form and submit it at the admission office for processing.

The list of selected candidates will be posted on the official website to ensure transparency and accessibility. The shortlisted candidates will also be informed of their selection via email and SMS channels that will include a fee payment link. Selected candidates must pay the prescribed program fee within the stipulated period as mentioned in the communication. Failure to do so may result in the forfeiture of the admission offer.

The institution reserves the right to specify walk-in admission dates and timings, which will be communicated through official channels, including the institution's website and notice boards. Applicants should come prepared with all required documentation and fees, if applicable. Walk-in admissions are subject to seat availability.

This policy will be reviewed periodically to reflect changes in regulations, institutional priorities, and best practices in the field of higher education.

MCC is dedicated to maintaining the highest standards of academic excellence while valuing diversity and fostering a welcoming environment for students from all backgrounds.

- UG Students are expected to study one mandatory language course


