- ✍ Students need to have a creative, yet logical mind that is fashion conscious, and can take a practical approach to transfer creative thinking into wearable garments.

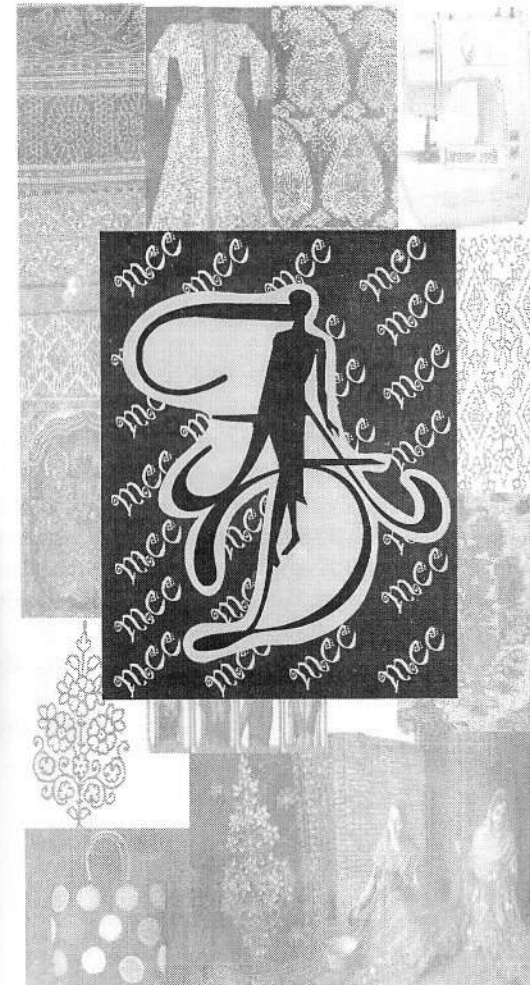
